Year 3 Spring Holiday Special G.A Course (6 - 9 October 2020)

Spring Holiday Special G.A. Course is an Intensive 4-day course to reinforce students' general ability skill in preparation for the OC placement tests next year. Students will be introduced to each type of general ability concepts and practice solving the G.A. questions under the guidance of a teacher.

General ability sessions focus on specific types of general ability questions asked in the OC placement test. Students will be introduced to each of the concepts, solve the practice questions, and will receive helpful tips and strategies. Students will then apply their knowledge by attempting homework questions at home. General ability session includes the 30 minutes computer-marked multiple choice test every day to assess the student's understanding of the topics covered during the session. Students will work on **verbal and nonverbal reasoning**, including following concepts.

- Synonyms / Antonyms
- Number Sets
- Odd one Out
- Anagrams
- General Coding
- Figure relationships
- Letter Patterns
- Word Classifications
- 2D, 3D Shapes
