- By taking STTC reading trial tests students will develop their comprehension skills to be able to grasp main ideas from the given stimulus texts.
- ✓ Through Maths trial tests, students will receive unrivalled benefit in that the questions are similar in nature and style to the questions in the real exam.
- ✓ General ability trial test practice is the most critical part of the course. Without constant practice, students will have great difficulty in solving 60 questions within 40 minutes. Students practise to manage time efficiently, minimise careless mistakes and increase accuracy, overcome exam nerves and feel confident on the exam date.



Essay Writing Course (Sat. Tue. Wed.)



The Year 6 Essay Writing Course will commence on Saturday, 25th January and support students' development of technical and essay writing skills. Please refer to the term 1 timetable below.

Year 6 Essay Writing course will cover areas including grammar, spelling and punctuation that pertain to specific text types as is required in the children's current English Curriculum.

Writing is an essential skill, required for the Selective High School Placement Test, for High School and beyond. Students will depend on their writing to communicate their ideas, to express their opinions, and even to persuade others.

The course focuses on the types of writing required for Selective and Scholarship tests, which are mainly narrative, creative and descriptive, enabling students to produce outstanding pieces of writing in just 20 minutes.

The course aims to target students' individual needs in writing and to help them become more confident, capable and proficient writers. It will also assist students with their individual performance in all written tasks in the classroom as well as formalised tests such as the Selective High School Placement Test and ICAS Assessments.

The 26th ASAT test schedule has been confirmed to be held on **Sunday, 2nd February 2020** 12:30pm - 4:30pm at Hall 3&4 Showground, Sydney Olympic Park.

The ASAT is superior to other practice exams in producing up-to-date questions and implementing exam information upgrades parallel to that of the actual selective school exam.

Participation in the ASAT provides an opportunity for students to gain a measure of their current achievement level under the same exam conditions as an actual exam.

It will be the last ASAT before the actual selective school placement tests and will greatly help parents to <u>review their current school choices in their application</u>. The ASAT outcome reports will provide the estimated profile score and rank as well as other information about their achievement level.
