Introducing STTC 1+1 Reading Test & Writing Re-Test

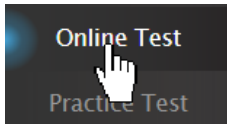
Dear STTC students,

From Term 3 2020, Cyberschool will provide a new STTC online 1+1 reading test and writing retest service during the term (NSW only). We highly encourage our STTC students to use these services to enhance their reading comprehension and writing skills under exam conditions. Details are as follows.

STTC 1+1 Reading test (online)

After completion of reading trial test for the week, students can attempt additional reading test in the following week (Math/G.A test week). The test will be online format at the Cyberschool and contains 45 questions to be completed in 40 minutes. Students can check their test result at the 'My Result' menu.

How to take the STTC 1+1 Reading test



STEP 1

Login to the Cyberschool and go to 'Online Test' menu.



STEP 2

Click 'STTC' tab at the top left of the test window.



STEP 3

Click 'Start' button under Reading 1+1 to begin the test.



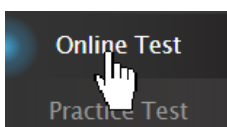
STEP 4

When you completed the test, click 'Finish' button at the top right corner.

STTC Writing Retest (online)

When your writing trial test score for the week is below the test average mark, you can attempt it again in the following week, with the same writing task. Type and submit your writing in 20 minutes in the test window. We will then assess your second writing and provide a feedback for further improvement. Please note that the writing retest score does not replace your original writing score.

How to take the STTC writing Re-Test



STEP 1

Login to the Cyberschool and go to 'Online Test' menu.



STEP 2

Click 'STTC' tab at the top left of the test window.



STEP 3

Click 'Start' button under **Writing Re-Test** to begin the test.



STEP 4

When you completed your writing, click 'Finish' at the top right corner.

Questions & Answers

Q. When and how long can I access the STTC 1+1 Reading test and Writing Re-Test services?

A. The services open during normal term STTC Math/G.A trial test week (Saturday to Friday) only and not available during the holiday STTC. The table below shows the term 3 service period.

Q. When I go to the online test page, I can't see the STTC tab.

A. The STTC tab is only visible during the scheduled service period – See the table above. It's not visible if you discontinued the STTC.

Q. There is no start button for the writing retest in my test window.

A. If you didn't take the writing test in the previous week, its retest is not available.

Q. After the 1+1 reading test or writing retest, how can I check my test result?

A. Go to the 'My Result' page of the Cyberschool. You will then see your STTC outcome table like below. The last two columns show your 1+1 reading test and writing retest scores.

Q. What does the 1+1 reading test screen look like?

A. It looks like the NAPLAN online reading test screen. Refer to the sample screenshot below.
