WEMG Course

WEMG course is designed to provide an advanced curriculum and involves a significant commitment to the module of work in Writing, English, Maths and General Ability. Taking this course allows students to build a solid foundation for the Selective High School Placement Test and the independent school scholarship tests. The course will be delivered in both way – ‘Standard WEMG course’ in a normal face-to-face class and online ‘Cyber WEMG course’ using the Cyberschool services only. Students can choose the course option according to their needs and learning style.

- **Writing** module provides the most efficient skills in organising writing structure with a focus on developing critical thinking and reasoning skills.
- **English** lesson will focus on reading skills and practising reading comprehension & multiple-choice questions.
- **Mathematics** lesson is the essential tuition for students to thoroughly understand mathematical theories, principles and formulas to solve problems.
- **General Ability** lesson will cover both Verbal and Non-verbal reasoning skills with a variety of practical, challenging and mind-stimulating questions.

Selective Trial Test Course (STTC)

The Selective Trial Test Course (STTC) is the most important preparation course for Year 5 students to maximise their performance in the selective high school placement test next year on 11th March 2021.

Students complete two tests each week – maths and general ability tests in one week and reading and writing tests in another week. There is additional **vocabulary test** during the reading & writing test week. Students are given the vocabulary list for the week and memorise them before the next vocabulary test.

STTC 1+1 Reading test (online)

After completion of reading trial test for the week, students can attempt additional reading test in the following week (Math/G.A test week). The test will be online format at the Cyberschool and contains 45 questions to be completed in 40 minutes. Students can check their test result at the 'My Result' menu.

STTC Writing retest (online)

When students' writing test score is below than test average mark, they may attempt it again in the following week with the same writing topic. Students complete their writing retest at the Cyberschool and get additional feedback from the teachers for further improvement. (The retest score will not be counted.)

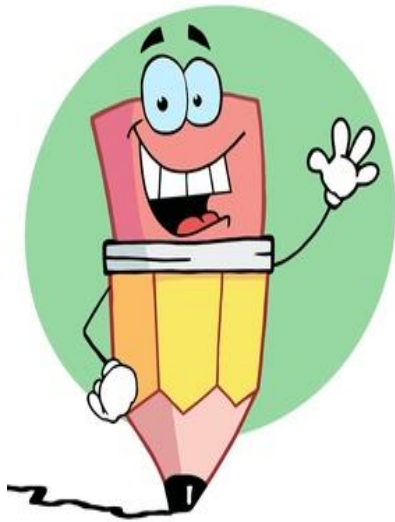

Year 5 Essay Writing Course will support students' development of technical and essay writing skills.

It will cover areas including grammar, spelling and punctuation that pertain to specific text types as is required in the student's current English Curriculum.

The aim of this course is to target students' individual needs in writing so they can become more confident, capable and proficient writers.

It will assist students with their individual performance in all written tasks in the classroom as well as formalised tests such as the selective high school placement test and independent school scholarship tests.

Arrival and Departure

- There will be restrictions on access to the college for anyone other than the college staff and students. Parents are to please contact the college by phone or email as required.
- Staff and parents are to observe physical distancing measures by not congregating in areas inside or around the campus. Adults must keep 1.5m away from other adults.
- Due to the limited capacity in each class, attending another class to make up the missed class will not be allowed.

Hygiene Arrangements

- The cleaning of classrooms and shared spaces has increased and will continue.
- All classrooms are equipped with hand sanitising stations. Students will be continually reminded of the need to wash and sanitise their hands throughout the day.
- Prominent signage across the campus in relation to COVID-19 that covers hand washing, personal hygiene, cough etiquette and social distancing.
- Students and teachers will largely remain in the same classrooms where possible.
- Students must not share food, drinks, water and stationery. Bring your own drink bottle.

Management of an unwell student

- Students experiencing symptoms, such as fever, cough or sore throat, will be isolated in an appropriate space with supervision and collected by a parent/carer as soon as possible.
- A medical certificate is not required to return to the college after a period of illness, however students should not return until symptoms resolve.
- If a student spreads droplet by sneezing, coughing or vomiting, surfaces will be immediately cleaned with disinfectant wipes (and using gloves).

Response protocols for COVID-19 cases

- Where there is a case of COVID-19 in the college, parents and students will be notified for the contact tracing process and to have the college site thoroughly cleaned.
- Information about the operational status of the college will be notified using the text message, email and website.
- During this period, online learning option will be made available through the Cyberschool or another website to enable students to do the makeup lesson at home.
- Parents and students will be notified when the college is ready to resume onsite learning.
