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Welcome to Pre-Uni New College Cyberschool!

Cyberschool is a special e-learning website (www.cyberschool.com.au) hosted by Pre-Uni New College and provides the extensive educational services to help students revise their entire Pre-Uni New College class work. Students can register for their own Cyberschool account to access its services.

Services vary depending on the course registered, and each service has its due date so students should enjoy all provided services until expiry as there is no extension.

Once registered Year 5 WEMT Course, students can:

- download **Module Answers** until the last day of next holiday.
- watch **Video Lessons** for revision within given period.
- access **Live Webinar** session for revision.
- try online quizzes (**S.O.Q**) to revise their module concepts during the term.
- try weekly **Vocabulary Tests** to assess knowledge of the meaning and use of the words during the term.
- try weekly **TS/MR Homework Questions** for extra practice during the term.
- try weekly **S-Maths Homework** to develop strong mathematical skills during the term.
- try **WEMT Re-Writing** on Lesson & Review weeks and gets additional feedback. (**Standard WEMT Advanced ONLY**)
- attempt online **Term Test** on Week 8, download **Term Test Report** during the **Term Test Review** period and review up to 10 questions missed in Maths/TS term tests.
- try **GA Practice for Scholarship Test** and **Reading 310** for more practice during the term.

Once registered Year 5 STTC Course, students can:

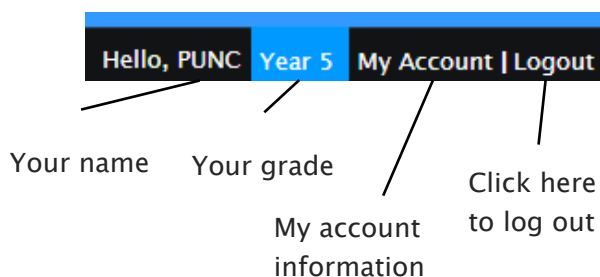
- try **1+1 Reading** test questions for extra practice during TS/MR test weeks.

How can I get my Cyberschool account?


1. Go to www.cyberschool.com.au.
2. Click 'Register' on the top right corner of the main page.




3. Enter your student id number, date of birth and email address in the registration fields. Click the 'Submit' button.
4. Once you have submitted, you will be given a verification email, where it will contain the activation link.
5. Check your email inbox to find the verification email from the Cyberschool team. **If you can't find it in your inbox, check the junk folder. It will be there, if so, unmark it as junk.**
6. Click on the activation link. **If the link doesn't work, copy and paste the link into the address bar of your internet browser and press the enter key.**
7. The link will open a window for password creation (Sign Up) page. Enter your desired password twice in the following fields and click Submit.
8. Once registered, you will be logged into the site. The login status bar is located on the top right of the page which looks like Fig 1 below. If you want to log out, click 'Logout'.
9. Next time you want to log in, click 'Login' and enter your student number and password.

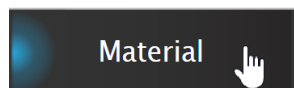

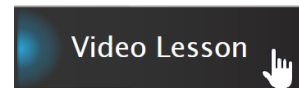

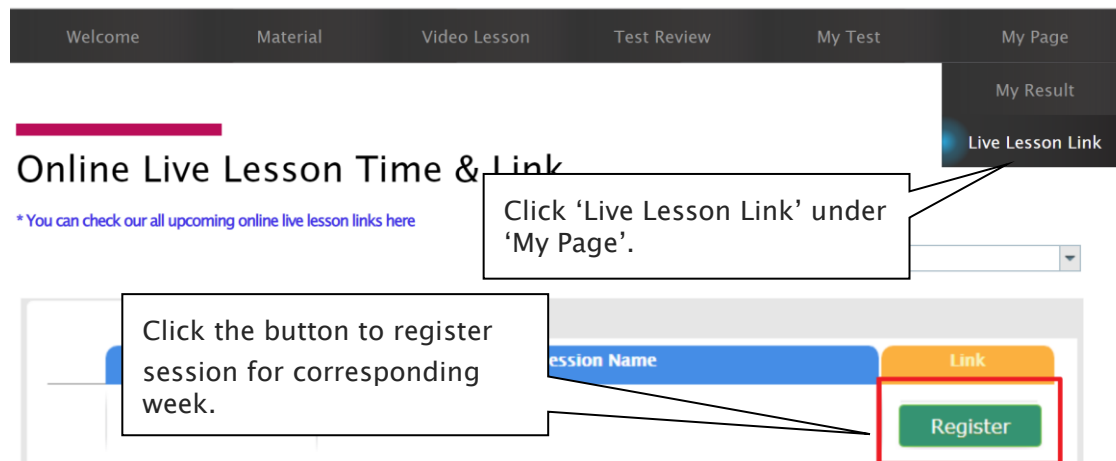

What is S.O.Q?

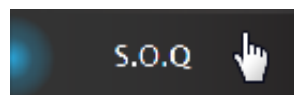
The **S.O.Q** (Special Online Quiz) service will enable students to practise their revision questions online at their own pace.

4 quizzes will be uploaded in weeks **2** (Modules 1&2), **4** (Modules 3&4), **6** (Modules 5&6) and **8** (Modules 7&8) of the course. Each quiz will have 10 Maths, 10 English and 10 Thinking Skills questions. Although it is not compulsory, we encourage students to complete all S.O.Q to build up a solid foundation in each area.

The **Special Online Quiz** will expire at the end of every term. Please note the date and remember to access them when available.

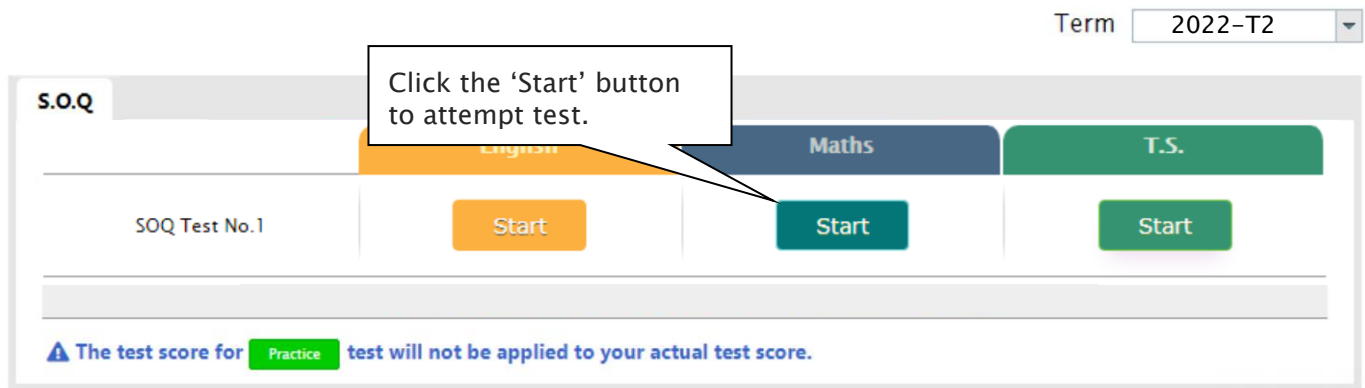

6. **[Fig. 3]** S.O.Q completion chart will be included on the Term Test Report, so please finish all tests by Week 9 of the term.



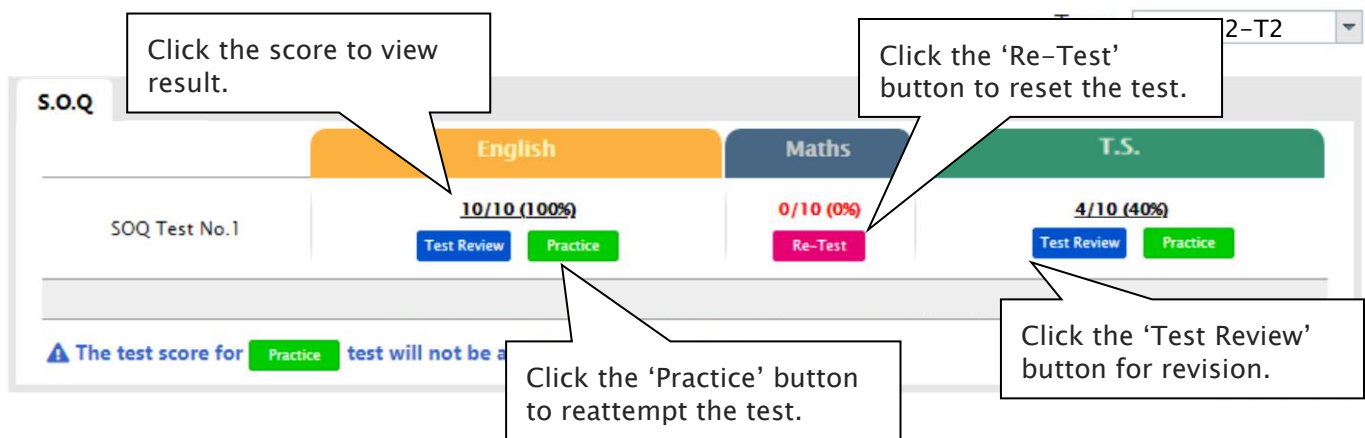

What is Vocabulary Test?

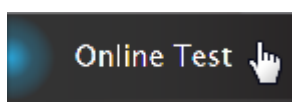
Building a strong vocabulary is critical as it improves all areas of communication and leads them to succeed in future selection tests like OC and selective high school exam. Students with high vocabulary skills tend to have high comprehension scores in English and thinking skills tests.

For these reasons, Cyberschool is offering students the online vocabulary test each week. Students study and memorise a set of word list in the Vocabulary Skills module during the week and take the test to assess their knowledge of the meaning and use of those words.

The **Vocabulary Test** will expire at the end of every term. Please note the date and remember to access them when available.

How to Do Vocabulary Test

1. Click the 'Online Test' below 'My Test' on the top menu bar.
2. [Fig. 1] Click 'Start' of each module's test.
3. Read the instructions and when you are ready, click 'Start.'

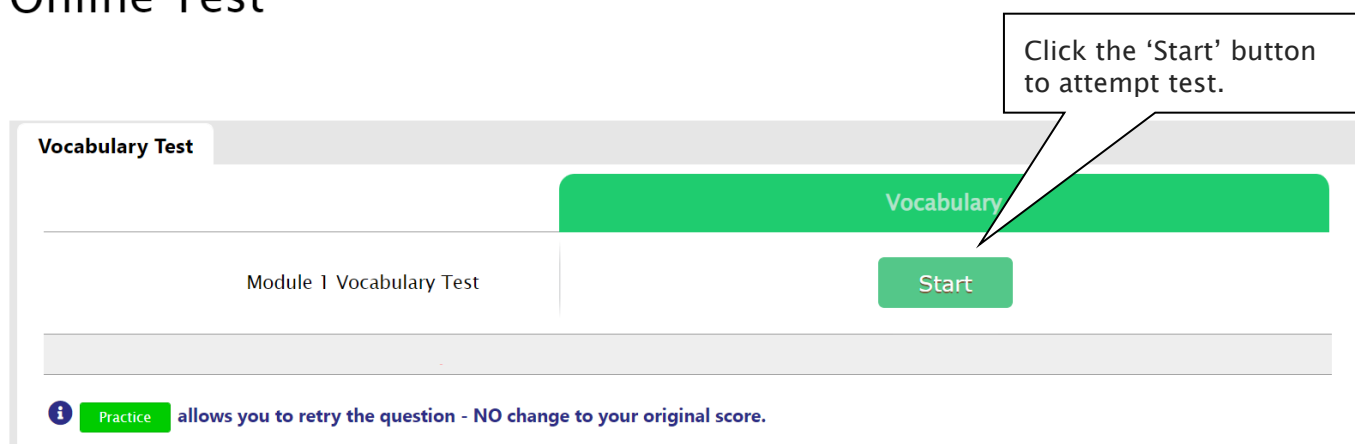

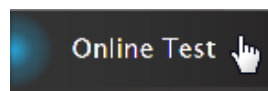
What is TS/MR Homework Question?

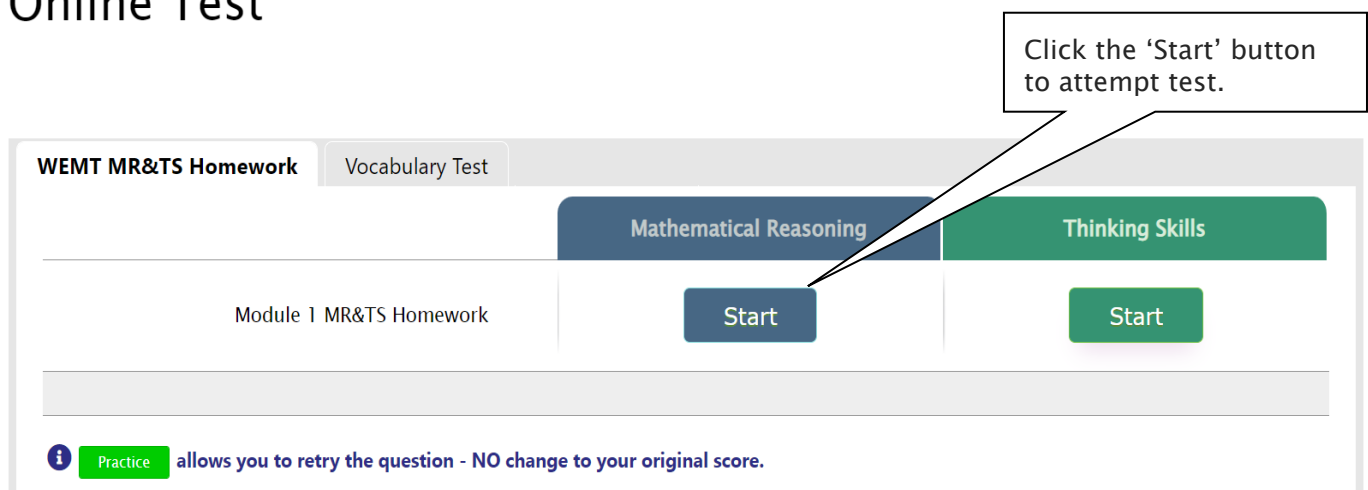

What is Year 5 Standard WEMT Re-Writing?

To make students engage more deeply with the WEMT writing modules, Year 5 writing lesson format has been updated as below.

- **WRITING WEEK** (weeks 1, 3, 5...): Students complete their writing module in class under teacher's guidance and submit for teacher's marking and feedback.
- **LESSON & REVIEW WEEK** (weeks 2, 4, 6...): Teachers return the marked writing to students with feedback. They then discuss more in-depth with students using the review module.

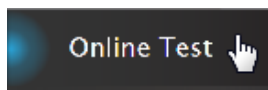
In addition to writing activity in class, Cyberschool will provide **Year 5 Standard WEMT Advanced** students with a new online rewriting service from this term. Students are encouraged to use this new service to get more feedback on their writing for further improvement.



After reviewing the previous week's writing module with your teacher, you can attempt the same module task again at home. Log in to Cyberschool and submit your rewriting by the due date. Your teacher will then assess it and provide additional feedback.

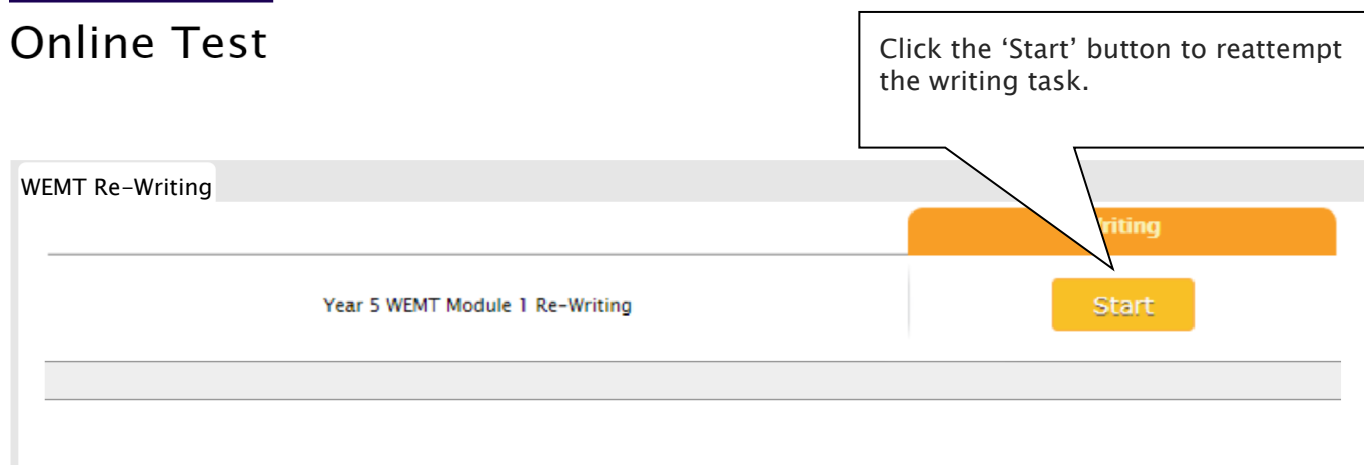
How to Do WEMT Re-Writing

Year 5 Standard WEMT Re-Writing – FAQ

- Q. Who can access the WEMT rewriting service?
- A. It's for Year 5 Standard WEMT (Advanced) students in New South Wales. **Not** applicable for the **Cyber WEMT** and other grade students.
- Q. When and how long can I access the WEMT rewriting service?
- A. The service will open on 'Lesson & Review' week (weeks 2, 4, 6 and 8) and available until the expiry date of each module.
- Q. Is there a time limit for rewriting?
- A. Yes, you will have 30 minutes to type and submit your writing. If you feel like you don't have enough time to do it in 30 minutes, you may type your writing on a separate program (like word or notepad) before accessing the service, and copy/paste into the rewriting text section and submit.
- Q. After submitting my rewriting, how can I check the outcome?
- A. Once your teacher finished the assessment of your rewriting (usually 1 week later), you can check it at 'My Result' page.
- Q. I am Year 5 Standard WEMT (Advanced) Zoom course student, how can I submit the writing task on writing week?
- A. Writing task will open at 'WEMT Writing' tab under 'Online Test' section during WRITING WEEK (weeks 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9).

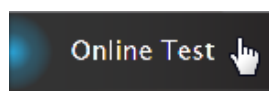
What is Year 5 Supplementary Maths Homework?

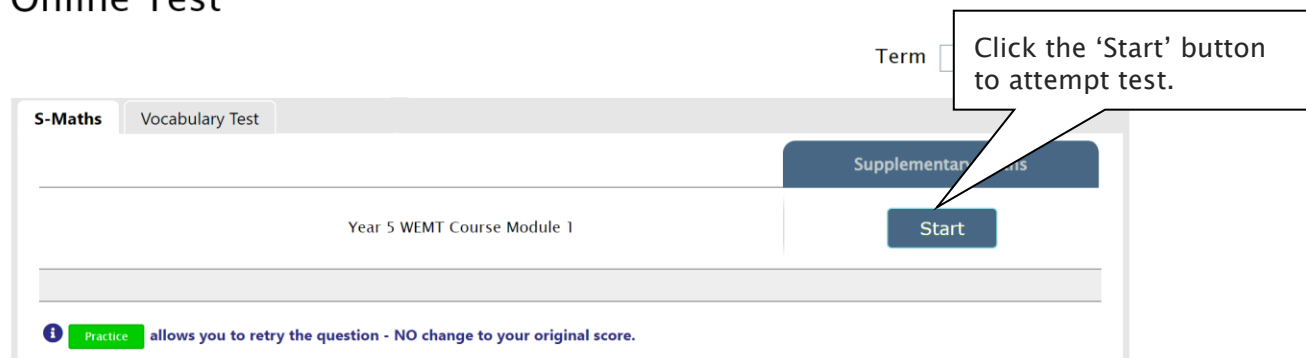

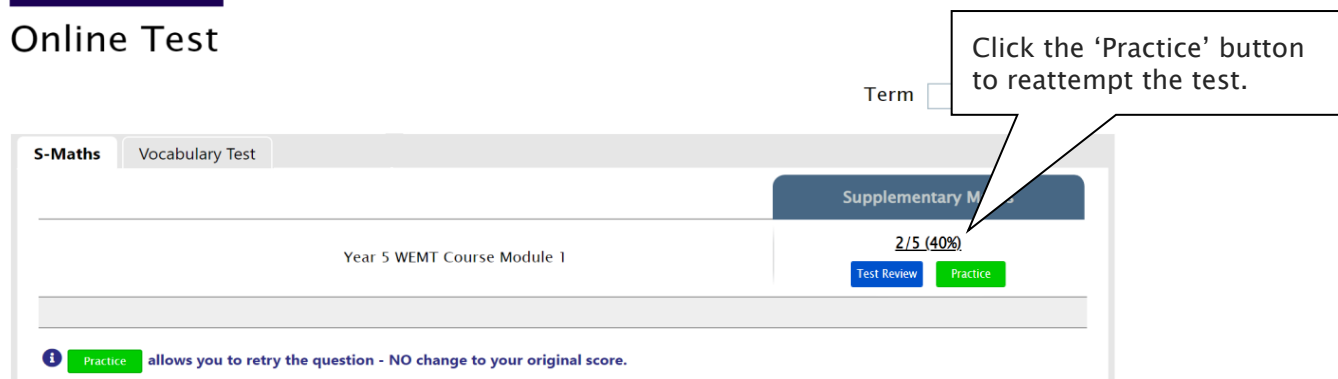

What is the Online Term Test and Test Review?

Year 5 WEMT course students will take the term tests in week 8 of each term. Term test is for assessment and subsequent reporting — generating valuable feedback for students and parents, this also will be the only indicator of next term's class allocation.

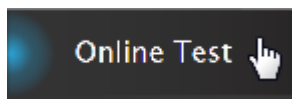
Students must complete all tests within the test opening period as there will be NO catch-up tests available after the test period.

Term test reports will be sent out to the parents by email at the end of the term. The report contains the information about total marks, achievement level (position), comprehensive comments on each test component and students' Special Online Quiz (S.O.Q) scores. Students must complete all S.O.Q by Week 9 to make the scores available on their report.

Students can access the term test review service during the first week of each school holiday period and review the (max 10) Maths and Thinking Skills term test questions they missed. They are encouraged to revise all questions it provides and build up a solid foundation before their next term's studies.

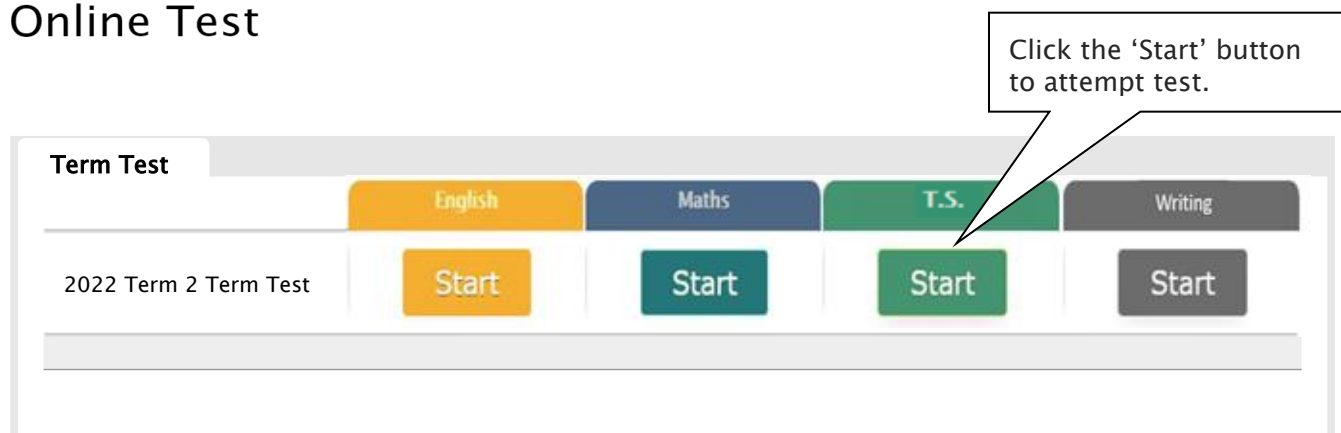
How to Complete the Online Term Test

1. Login to the Cyberschool during the online term test period.
2. Move your mouse cursor on the 'My Test' menu and click 'Online Test'. Click 'Term Test' tab at the top of the screen.
3. [Fig. 1] You will then see the test subjects and start buttons like below. Click 'Start' button to begin the test.
4. Read the test instruction and when you're ready, click 'Start' at the bottom of the screen.
5. Read each question carefully and show your answer using the mouse.
6. When you completed the test, click 'Finish' button at the bottom right corner.



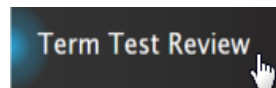

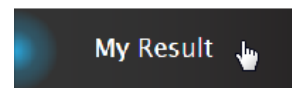

Term Test Review – FAQ

Q. When can I see the questions after the term test?

- A. The term test review service will be available during the first week of each school holiday period (Mon–Sun). Please don't miss out the service during the first week of each school holiday.

Q. I can't see any question. What's the problem?

- A. The service retrieves the questions you incorrectly answered in the Maths and Thinking Skills tests. Therefore, if there is no test result of you (i.e. you didn't take the test or your test hasn't been marked yet.), it does not show any question.

Q. I can't find the question I want to see.

- A. It shows maximum of 10 questions based on your term test result. If you missed out more than 10 questions, the hardest 10 questions are selected for your review. If the question you want to see is not harder than the chosen 10 questions, it will not appear.

Q. When I click the 'My Result' menu, it says 'no result available'.

- A. My Result service is available during the term test review period only. When the review period has expired, it's not accessible.

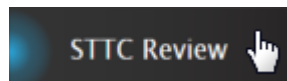

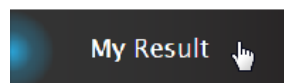

STTC Review & Test Result– FAQ

Q. How long can I see the questions once they become available?

A. The questions of each test are available to review for **fourteen (14) days only** – from the following week of the each test starting date.

Q. I can't see any questions. What's the problem?

A. The service automatically retrieves the M.R./T.S. questions you incorrectly answered in the recent STTC session, unless you didn't attend the test, or the test results haven't yet been recorded.

Q. I can't find the question I want to see.

A. It shows maximum of 10 Mathematical Reasoning and 10 Thinking Skills questions based on your actual test result. If you missed out more than 10 questions in each test, the hardest 10 questions are selected for your review. If the question you want to see is not harder than the chosen 10 questions already provided, it will not appear.

Q. Can I see the questions from earlier tests?

A. The service only provides the recent STTC questions. The 14-day review policy will be strictly implemented, so please don't miss out the review service each test within its review period.

Q. Can I see the questions from English test?

A. Only top 5 students' writing with teacher's comment is available to view. By comparing the top 5 students' writing with teacher's comment, you can improve your writing. Please read teacher's comment why those 5 students' writing is selected as the top writings.

Q. I can see my test score, but not my rank.

A. Your rank will be shown after gathering all other students' results, which usually takes one week of the test. Please check again on the following Saturday.

Q. When can I get my overall ranking and overall score?

A. To be able to produce the correct overall score and ranking, we need to collect all test scores (Reading, Writing, Mathematical Reasoning and Thinking Skills) from all STTC students. Therefore, it usually takes two weeks. Please check them out two weeks later after your test.

Q. My Mathematical Reasoning score is 24. Does it mean I got 24% correct answers?

A. No, it's your raw (original) test score – number of questions you answered correctly in the test. So, your Mathematical Reasoning score 24 means you got 69% (24 out of 35) correct answers.

Q. How was my overall score calculated?

A. Overall score (Maximum score: 100) = Reading (25%) + Writing(15%) + M.R.(25%) + T.S.(35%)

Q. Can I use the overall score to estimate my actual placement score?

A. The actual placement score is complex and require many calculations including test score scaling and moderation of school assessment scores. Your STTC test scores are not scaled and your overall score doesn't count your moderated school marks. Therefore, you cannot directly compare those two marks.

Q. I discontinued my STTC. Can I still access my previous STTC results online?

A. No, it's only available during your STTC enrolment period. When you resume your STTC, it will become available again.

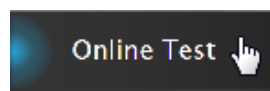
What is 1+1 Reading?

The **STTC 1+1 Reading** service opens during **normal term STTC M.R./T.S. trial test weeks only** and not available during the holiday course period.

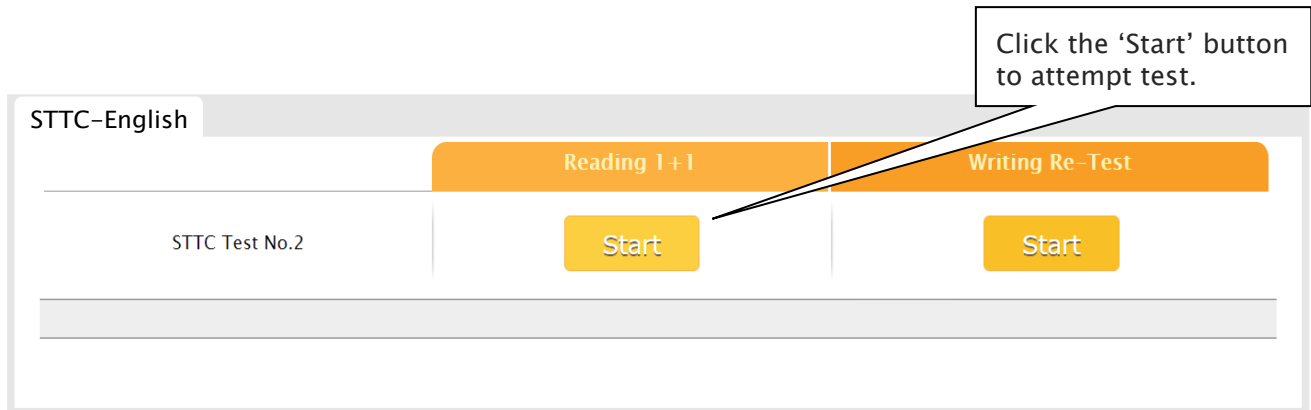

What is Vocabulary List & Vocab Practice Test?

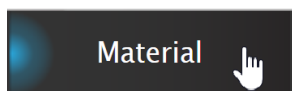

What is Poem Annotation Guide Video & Worksheet?

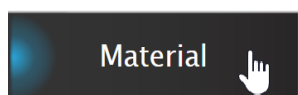
Poem interpretation ability is very important to achieve high scores in the reading test, as the questions based on poetry always appear in the selective school placement test.
