When and where will the test be held?

- The scholarship tests will be held on Sunday, 3rd December 2023, at 9am or 1pm AEDT.
- The test will be held online at your home. There are <u>NO</u> catch-up sessions available for missed test.

What are the test components?

- The test consists of three 30-minute sections: reading, mathematics, and reasoning.
- All questions are multiple-choice.

What are the technical requirements?

Cyberschool Account	 To take the scholarship tests, you must have a Cyberschool account. If you don't have one or forgot your password, follow the instructions below: <u>If you are a new student</u>, you should have received a registration email from Cyberschool upon payment. Follow the instructions in the email to create your Cyberschool account. <u>If you forget your password</u>, click the "Forgot your password?" link on the Login page and follow the steps provided.
Computer	You must use a Windows or Mac desktop or laptop computer with a built-in webcam. Your operating system must be Windows 7 or higher or macOS Sierra 10.12.1 or higher.
Browser	You must use the Google Chrome browser to avoid technical issues during the test
Punctuality	The test will start on time! There will be <u>no</u> catch-up session for missed tests

What happens if I'm late for the test?

You may enter the test page and start the test, but there is <u>no</u> extra time beyond the scheduled end time for the session.

When and where can I get my test outcome?

The outcome advice email will be sent out to the parents on 16th December 2023. The email will contain a link where you can download the test outcome report.

Can I review the test questions?

Students and parents <u>cannot</u> review any test questions.
