Year 2 WEMG Course

The Year 2 WEMG course requires a significant amount of weekly work in the subjects of writing, English, mathematics, and general ability, which reflects the advanced level of the curriculum. Along with providing students an advantage over their peers, this course also prepares them for the NAPLAN and Opportunity Class Placement Test.

The writing module of the course places emphasis on organising writing structures and enhancing critical thinking and reasoning skills. The English lessons concentrate on improving reading skills, particularly reading comprehension and answering multiple-choice questions. Mathematics lessons play a crucial role in helping students gain a thorough understanding of mathematical theories, principles, and formulas to solve problems. The General ability lesson includes an assorted range of thought-provoking and challenging questions that assess both verbal and non-verbal reasoning skills.

Students have the option to choose the WEMG course that best suits their needs:

Standard WEMG (Face-to-face learning)	Cyber WEMG (Self-paced learning with VOD lesson)

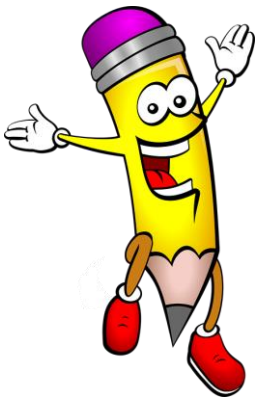

Year 2 Writing Course (Wednesday)



The aim of the Year 2 Writing course is to improve students' technical and imaginative writing skills. The course has a personalised approach to cater to each student's specific writing needs, which fosters confidence, competence, and expertise in writing.

This program will aid students in improving their writing skills for all written assignments at school, as well as writing exams for NAPLAN, ICAS Assessments and selective high school placement. Emphasis will be placed on narrative writing skills, including grammar, spelling, and punctuation, which are crucial components of the course curriculum.

In the upcoming Term 4, students will have the opportunity to enhance their writing skills by delving deeper into the concept of simple, compound, and complex sentences. They will focus on gaining a comprehensive understanding of the recount, procedure, information report, description, persuasive, narrative, and letter writing.

Additionally, students will be encouraged to apply their knowledge to create meaningful and coherent sentences in their writing exercises.
