### Year 3 WEMT Course

The Year 3 WEMT program is undergoing a curriculum revamp that involves the inclusion of new modules and a significant increase in weekly commitment for students. The revised curriculum features a thinking skills component that prepares students for the 2024 OC placement test. The writing module is focused on the development of critical thinking and reasoning skills, as well as teaching effective writing organisation methods. English lessons concentrate on enhancing reading skills, comprehension, and the ability to answer multiple-choice questions. In mathematics sessions, students will master mathematical theories, principles, and formulas to solve problems with ease. The thinking skills lesson will challenge students with a range of practical and mentally stimulating questions to improve their problem-solving and critical thinking skills. Students can choose from one of the following WEMT courses that best suits their needs.

# OC Foundation Course (OCFC)

- The OCTTC framework has been updated to accommodate new types of questions appeared in the recent OC placement tests. It will consist of 11 sessions of OC Foundation Course (OCFC) in Term 4, followed by the OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC) from Term 1 next year.
- Term 4 OC Foundation Course (OCFC) is a special foundation course designed for Year 3 students to maximise their performance in the OCTTC and actual OC exam next year. Each week, students attempt the OC exam style questions – reading tests in one week and mathematical reason & thinking skills tests in another week. Teachers will then go through the questions and teach how to interpret the questions and find correct solutions.
- The OCFC is unique in a way that it gives students a clear understanding of different OC question types and help students to build up their self-confidence in the 2024 OC Placement Test. It will also provide a very effective springboard for future success in their selective school placement exam.
