The term 2 courses are designed to align with the rigorous academic requirements for students targeting admission to Opportunity Class (OC) after their OC placement tests in July this year.



# Year 4 WEMT Course

The Year 4 WEMT course is revamping its curriculum with new modules and is set to demand a substantial weekly commitment from students. The updated curriculum includes a thinking skills component aimed at preparing students for the 2023 Opportunity Class placement test.

The writing module focuses on developing critical thinking and reasoning skills and teaches students the most effective methods for organising writing structure. English lessons concentrate on honing reading skills and practicing comprehension and answering multiple-choice questions. Mathematics lessons are crucial for students to master mathematical theories, principles, and formulas, and to be able to solve problems with ease. The thinking skills lesson offers a range of practical, challenging, and mentally stimulating questions to help students improve their problem-solving and critical thinking skills. Students can choose from one of the following WEMT courses that best suits their needs:

#### Standard WEMT

(Face-to-face learning)

Face-to-face learning with teachers in class & access all Cyberschool services

#### Standard WEMT (Live Zoom lesson)

Live zoom lessons from home with teachers & access all Cyberschool services

#### Cyber WEMT (Video lesson)

Self-paced learning from home using pre-recorded Cyberschool video lessons

# OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC)

The Year 4 Opportunity Class Trial Test Course (OCTTC) is vital for students preparing for the 2023 Opportunity Class placement test.

The course provides weekly assessments to evaluate the student's knowledge and test performance. By regularly taking OC trial tests, students will have the opportunity to refine their exam-taking skills and feel confident on the day of the actual exam. The course features questions of various types, mimicking the format, timing, and conditions of the actual exam, allowing students to practice managing their time efficiently, reducing errors, overcoming test anxiety, and performing to the best of their abilities.

Students will take the mathematical reasoning and thinking skills tests in one week, followed by reading tests the following week, taking two weeks to complete a set of OC trial tests. After the test, students will review the questions with their teacher, with a particular emphasis on challenging questions. For further information, kindly refer to the 2023 OTTC newsletter.



The objective of the course is to address each student's unique writing needs, leading to improved confidence, competency, and mastery in writing. The course will support students' individual performance in all written assignments at school, including the NAPLAN, selective school placement writing test, and independent school scholarship writing exam. Additionally, the course will cover grammar, spelling, and punctuation relevant to the various text types in the curriculum.
