Year 5 WEMT Course

The Year 5 WEMT course is being updated to include new module contents. This will require students to commit to a significant amount of weekly module work, but it will help them build a solid foundation for the NAPLAN and selective school exam. The writing module will teach students how to organise their writing in the most efficient way possible, with a focus on developing critical thinking and reasoning skills. The English module will focus on reading skills, practicing reading comprehension and multiple-choice questions. The mathematics module is essential for students to thoroughly understand mathematical theories, principles, and formulas to solve problems. The thinking skills module will cover a variety of practical, challenging, and mind-stimulating questions in problem solving and critical thinking skills. Students can choose one of the following WEMT courses according to their needs:

NAPLAN & Selective Trial Test Course (STTC)

The term 1 NAPLAN & Selective Trial Test Course is a new comprehensive program designed for Year 5 students to prepare them for both NAPLAN and Selective High School Placement Test (SHSPT).

In Term 1, there will be a six-week NAPLAN trial test period from 27 January for the 2024 NAPLAN tests, followed by five-week selective trial test sessions from 9 March, to prepare students for the 2025 selective school exam. The tests will be conducted in a computer-based format (CBT) requiring students to use computers provided in the classroom.

By taking this trial test course, students will be able to practise NAPLAN & SHSPT style questions under exam conditions and learn how to manage their test time efficiently, minimise errors, overcome exam nerves and perform at their optimum level in the actual exam. It will help them to build their confidence to succeed in both 2024 NAPLAN and the 2025 selective high school placement tests.
