Year 6 WEMT Course

Year 6 WEMT course requires a significant commitment of weekly module work to help students build a solid foundation for the 2024 selective school placement test. The **writing** module teaches students the most efficient ways in organising writing structure with a focus on developing critical thinking and reasoning skills. **English** lesson will focus on reading skills, practising comprehension and multiple-choice questions. **Mathematics** lessons are essential for students to thoroughly understand mathematical theories, principles and formulas to solve problems. **Thinking skills** covers a variety of practical, challenging and mind-stimulating questions in problem solving and critical thinking skills. Students can choose one of the following WEMT course according to their needs or preferences:

Selective Trial Test Course (STTC)

Year 6 Selective Trial Test Course (STTC) is a comprehensive program designed to prepare students for the 2024 Selective High School Placement Test. The course encompasses a variety of question types that replicate the format, timing, and conditions of the actual exam.

During the course, students will take part in weekly trial tests and will learn the most effective strategies to approach selective exam-style questions. Additionally, they are expected to download and memorise the vocabularies provided on Cyberschool and complete the online vocab practice test.

Following the weekly trial tests, students will receive their test results via email, which can also be accessed through the 'My Result' menu on Cyberschool.

Cyberschool will offer extensive revision materials throughout the course, including the STTC challenge for reviewing mathematical reasoning and thinking skills tests, an additional reading test (1+1 reading), writing retests, writing test review videos, poem annotation tutorial videos and vocabulary practice tests.
