## 6+ Course – Outlines of teaching

### 6+ English

The aim of English classes is to provide students with the skills required to excel in reading, analysing, and writing a wide range of texts. The lessons aim to develop students' abilities to translate their analytical skills into written form, producing well-written essays and in-depth responses across multiple text genres. This will enable students to be confident and proficient in their use of the English language.

#### Key topics to be addressed in term 2:

- Informative texts & factual information
- Understanding different style of texts
- Analysing author's intent and purpose
- Literature technique including tone and characterisation
- Analysing and composing information report and articles
- Improve sophistication in writing
- Developing the skills of public speaking

### 6+ Mathematics

The 6+ Mathematics course is crafted to equip students with a strong foundation in problem-solving through a review of Year 6 curriculum and a preview of Year 7 content. It incorporates a wide range of engaging activities to deepen students' grasp of fundamental mathematical concepts, helping them to become confident and skilled mathematicians.

- Angles and Construction
- Properties of 2-D figures
- Number Theory
- Solids
- Directed Numbers and Number Plane
- Further Algebra
- Probability
- Time / Mass
