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Year 6 Winter Holiday Course Information

"The transition from Year 6 into Year 7 is an exciting yet important step!"

Year 6 winter holiday courses are specifically designed to support students in making a smooth and successful transition to Year 7. These courses focus on the development of essential skills, including independent research, analytical thinking, effective communication in reading, writing, and speaking, as well as consolidating crucial mathematical concepts. By participating in these courses, students will have the opportunity to build a strong foundation of skills and knowledge, instilling confidence as they embark on their Year 7 studies. The course schedule and topics covered are outlined below, providing students with a clear understanding of the valuable academic advantages they will gain.

Year 6 Writing, Debating & Speech Course (WEEK 1)

- ♣ Course Period: 3 7 July (Mon Fri: 5 days)

- Course Outline:

Writing Session (8:45am - 11:15am): Students will learn how to translate their analytical skills into writing coherent essays, reports, and extended responses in a variety of text types. It offers students the opportunity to read, analyse and enjoy many forms of literature including narratives, non-fiction, letter, feature articles and news reports. Students will learn how to write appropriate responses of various lengths to answer questions or respond to texts as they will be required to in high school.

Public speaking and debating (11:45am - 2:15pm) should no longer be something to be feared. It will cover the fundamental skills required on structuring and composing different types of speeches as well as all the aspects of delivering a potent and engaging speech. It strongly focuses on enhancing presentation and delivery skills including managing nerves, developing vocal variety, and using body language effectively. After taking this course, students will develop the confidence they need to speak in front of any audience.

Year 6 English & Mathematics Course (WEEK 2)

- Course Outline:

English Session (8:45am - 11:15am): Students will analyse a variety of texts and text types to help them to develop and master their reading comprehension skills, to prepare them for Year 7 English studies as well as NAPLAN tests. They will examine a variety of text types such as explanation texts, narrative, procedures and feature articles.

Mathematics Session (11:45am - 2:15pm): Students will learn a variety of higher-level maths problem-solving skills, giving them a brief insight into some high school mathematics. The key topics covered will include decimals, fractions, angles and geometry, algebraic techniques, perimeter, area and probability. By extending knowledge in these areas, students will gain confidence and become familiar with foundation concepts required in high school maths studies. Each topic will include a quiz and homework to consolidate students' understanding of the concepts learnt in the classroom.
