The 34th ASAT – Registration & Test Information

Who can register	The 34 th ASAT registration is open to Year 5 students who will sit the NSW selective high school placement test on 2 – 4 May 2025.
Test date	Sunday, 27 th October 2024
Test format	The test will be conducted using personal laptops (BYOD) and will consist of four sections: reading, writing, mathematical reasoning and thinking skills.
Test session	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9:00am – 12:30pm <u>OR</u> 1:30pm – 5:00pm session. • Session times are subject to change depending on number of participants.
Test Centre Locations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The test will take place at various locations close to Homebush, North Strathfield, Pennant Hills and Moorebank areas. • Parents will receive their child’s test centre advice letter by email starting from 22nd October with the exact test centre details.
Registration fee & Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$100 per applicant (<u>NO refunds and NO credits for cancellations</u>) • The discount price (\$90 per applicant) is available only to the students enrolled in the 2024 Term 1, Term 2 or Term 3 WEMT, STTC, Thinking Skills or Writing full-term course at Pre-Uni New College. • To register, visit the ASAT booking site and complete the registration. • Registration will close once all available seats are filled.
Special Offer	All registered 34th ASAT students will receive a free online trial test (worth \$100) after their results are released. (Terms and Conditions apply.)
What to bring to the test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptop: Ensure your laptop is secure in your bag. <u>See requirements below.</u> • Test Centre Advice Letter: Single-side printed copy • Pencils, eraser, water (in clear bottle), snack (no nuts or nut products).
Laptop (BYOD) Minimum Requirements	<p><u>Students must bring their laptop that meets the following requirements:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • O/S: Windows 10+, macOS Sierra 10.12.1+, or the latest Chrome OS. • Wi-Fi enabled: Your laptop must be able to connect to a wireless network. • <u>Your laptop must have a full charge before the test and able to operate for at least 4 hours without needing a power source. Please note that there will be NO power outlets available for your laptop. If you're worried about your laptop's battery, bring a fully charged power bank and a compatible cable.</u> • Web browser: Ensure your laptop has the latest version of a web browser installed. Google Chrome is recommended to avoid any technical issues. • <u>Please handle your laptop with care on test day. We are not liable for any damage or loss that may occur.</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tablet PCs or devices such as iPads and Galaxy Tabs are <u>not</u> compatible with the ASAT testing platform.
Laptop Rental Option	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you don't have a suitable laptop, we offer rentals for <u>\$50 per student</u>. However, availability is very limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please indicate your rental preference during the registration process. Once all rentals are booked, this option will no longer be available.• <u>Please note that parents will be responsible for any damage caused to the rental laptop due to their child's negligence or carelessness.</u>
Test outcome	Parents can anticipate receiving their child's test outcome advice email on 10 th November 2024. The email will contain a link to download their child's detailed outcome reports.
