Are you ready to unlock the secrets of your Term 1 WEMT novel and share your unique perspective with the world? Join our book review competition!

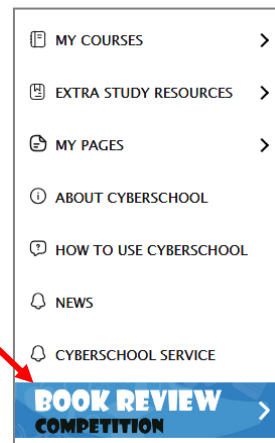

2025 Term 1 Book Review Competition – Rules & Conditions

1. This competition is open to Years 2 to 6 students who attend the 2025 Term 1 WEMT course at Pre-Uni New College.
2. All book reviews must be based on the novel chosen from the **2025 Term 1 Novel List**, corresponding to each student's grade – see Page 1.
3. Students must submit their comprehensive book reviews **via the 'Book Review Competition' menu on [Cyberschool](#) by Saturday, 3rd May 2025.**
4. Participants are required to ensure the coherency of sentences, accurate spelling, proper use of grammar and punctuation, as well as the appropriate organisation of paragraphs in their reviews. Marks will be awarded solely to well-presented and completed reviews, adhering to the book review guidelines provided below.

Year 2 Book Review

Write detailed answers to the following questions based on your Term 1 novel. Make sure to write in complete sentences.

- What is the title of your novel?
- Who is the author?
- Does the book have illustrations?
- Who is the illustrator?
- Who are the main characters in the story?
- What is the story about?
- Does the story have a special message?
- Which part of the story did you like most and why?
- Who do you think would like to read this book?

Years 3 to 6 Book Review

1. Book Summary

- What is the title of the book and who is the author?
- What type of narrative is the story? (e.g. adventure, fantasy, recount, mystery etc.)
- Who are the main characters and what is special about each of them? (Include information about their physical appearance, personality, interests, attitude to others etc.)
- Where is it set?
- What is the story about?
- Does the story have a moral?

2. Personal Opinion – What do you think?

- Is the book well written?
- Is the book exciting or not?
- Did the author use interesting words?
- Are there any illustrations? Are they effective in contributing to the story?
- Would you recommend this book?
- Who would you recommend it to?
