The 2025 ASAT for OC – Registration & Test Information

Who can register	Registrations are open to Year 4 students who will sit the NSW opportunity class (OC) placement test on 2 – 4 May 2025.
Test date	Saturday, 12th April 2025
Test format	The test will be conducted using personal laptops (BYOD) and will consist of three (3) sections: reading, mathematical reasoning and thinking skills.
Test session	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9:00am – 11:50am <u>OR</u> 1:00pm – 3:50pm session. • Session times are subject to change depending on number of participants.
Test Centre Locations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The test will take place close to Homebush and Rydalmere areas. • Parents will receive their child’s test centre advice letter by email starting from 8th April with the exact test centre details.
Registration fee & Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$80 per applicant (NO refunds and NO credits for cancellations) • Applicants are eligible for the discounted price of \$70 if they enrolled in at least one of the WEMT, NTTC, OCFC, Thinking Skills, Writing full-term courses (excluding holiday courses) at Pre-uni New College in 2024 or 2025. • Visit the <u>ASAT for OC website</u> and complete the online registration. • Registration will close once all available seats are filled.
What to bring to the test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptop: Ensure your laptop is secure in your bag. <u>See requirements below.</u> • Test Centre Advice Letter: Single-side printed copy • Pencils, eraser, water (in clear bottle), snack (no nuts or nut products). • If desired, students may bring a mouse for their laptop.
Laptop (BYOD) Minimum Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Operating System: Windows 10 or later, macOS Sierra 10.12.1 or later, or the latest Chrome OS. • Wi-Fi Connectivity: Your laptop must be capable of connecting to an offline wireless network. • Battery Life: Your laptop should be fully charged before the test and able to operate for <u>at least 4 hours</u> without needing a power source. Please note:

	<p>Power outlets will <u>not</u> be available during the test.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device Security: Ensure your child can access the laptop without any login issues. If a security lock is in place, ensure your child knows how to unlock the device. • Antivirus Software: Disable any antivirus software on your laptop to avoid potential conflicts with the ASAT testing platform. • Proxy & VPN Settings: Ensure <u>no</u> proxy or VPN settings are enabled on your device. • Web Browser: Your laptop should have the latest version of a web browser. Google Chrome is recommended to minimise potential technical difficulties. If you're using MacOS Safari, <u>turn off iCloud Private Relay</u> from System Settings menu. • Device Care: Please handle your laptop with care during the test. We are <u>not</u> responsible for any damage or loss that may occur. • Device Compatibility: Tablet PCs (e.g., iPads, Galaxy Tabs) are <u>not</u> compatible with the ASAT testing platform.
<p>Laptop Rental Option</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Laptop rentals are available for \$50 per student. However, supplies are very limited, and rentals will be given out on a first-come, first-served basis. • Please indicate your rental preference during the registration process. Once all rentals are booked, this option will <u>no</u> longer be available. • <u>Please note that parents will be responsible for any damage caused to the rental laptop due to their child's negligence or carelessness.</u>
