After the on-site ASAT, students receive a comprehensive performance report including section-by-section accuracy, overall and gender-specific ranks, performance bands and comparison charts. The online full-set mock tests provide results only and do not include these diagnostic reports.

With one of the largest datasets available, the on-site ASAT offers useful statistical indicators to support selective school preference decisions. While not definitive predictions, these data-driven insights can guide families as they consider school choices.

🧑‍🎓 Realistic Test-Day Experience

During the on-site ASAT, students follow supervisor instructions, manage scheduled breaks and navigate test-day routines in a supervised venue, giving them a realistic test-day experience that strengthens time management, exam readiness and confidence.

The 38th ASAT Registration & Test Information

Who can register	Registration is open to Year 5 students preparing to sit the 2027 Selective High School Placement Test .
Test date	- The on-site ASAT tests will be held on Sunday, 18 October 2026. - The two online full-set mock tests will be accessible from home during the designated access period, which will be provided after the on-site ASAT.
Registration fee	- The registration fee is \$110 per applicant, covering the main ASAT tests on 18 October 2026 as well as access to the online full-set mock tests offered afterward. - Please note that this fee is non-refundable and non-creditable in the event of cancellation. - A discounted fee of \$100 is available for students enrolled in a full-term WEMT, STTC, TS, or Writing course (excluding holiday courses) with us in Terms 1, 2 or 3 of 2026.
How to Register	Existing students: Log in to Cyberschool and select 'ASAT REGISTRATION' in the sidebar. New students: Visit the ASAT booking website to complete your registration. Please note: Spaces are limited; registration closes once capacity is reached.
Test format	The on-site test will be completed on each student's BYOD laptop, and will include 4 sections: - Reading: 17 questions (38 answers) in 45 minutes - Mathematical Reasoning: 35 questions (35 answers) in 40 minutes - Thinking Skills: 40 questions (40 answers) in 40 minutes - Writing: 1 typed task in 30 minutes
Test sessions	- Each student selects one on-site test session - morning or afternoon. - Session times may vary depending on the venue and number of participants. Final timings will be confirmed closer to the test date.
Test locations	- The on-site test will be held at venues near Strathfield and Rydalmere (Western Sydney University Parramatta South Campus). - From 13 October 2026, students will receive an email with their Test Centre Advice Letter, which will include full details of their test centre and confirmed session time.
Test outcome	Parents and guardians will receive an outcome email on 1st November 2026, including a link to download their child's detailed on-site test outcome reports.
What to bring to the on-site test	BYOD Laptop: Bring your own laptop that meets the minimum specifications - check the BYOD Laptop Minimum Requirements for full details. Test Centre Advice Letter: Bring a single-sided printed copy Stationery and essentials: Pencils, an eraser, water in a clear bottle, and a snack (no nuts or nut products). A mouse for use with your laptop is optional.
Laptop Rental Option	- Laptop rentals are \$50 per participant. Availability is limited and offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Please indicate your preference during registration. - Parents and guardians are responsible for any damage caused to rental laptops.

Backup Device Policy	If a student's BYOD laptop fails during the test, a rental laptop may be provided (subject to availability) for a flat \$50 fee. Parental permission will <u>not</u> be required at the time of issue.
BYOD Laptop Minimum Requirements	☑ OS: Windows 10 or later, macOS 25 or later, or the latest Chrome OS. ☑ Wi-Fi: Your laptop must be able to connect to the ASAT wireless network. ☑ Battery: Fully charged, minimum 4 hours of battery life (no power outlets available). ☑ Security: No login or password issues; students must know how to unlock their device. ☑ Chromebooks: ✓ <u>Guest Browsing</u> must be enabled in Privacy & Security settings. ✓ If your Chromebook is managed by your workplace or school and Guest Browsing <u>cannot</u> be enabled, bring a Windows laptop or a MacBook instead. ☑ Antivirus: Disable antivirus software to prevent conflicts with the ASAT CBT platform. ☑ Network: NO proxy or VPN settings enabled on your device. ☑ Web Browser: Google <u>Chrome</u> is strongly recommended. ✓ MacBook users must install the macOS version of Chrome and <u>iCloud Private Relay</u> must be <u>disabled</u> in System Settings app. ☑ Software Restrictions: ✓ Grammar/spell-checking tools (e.g., Grammarly) must <u>not</u> be installed or running. ✓ AI tools or AI-assisted software must <u>not</u> be installed or running. ✓ Detection of such tools may result in test invalidation. ☑ Device Compatibility: Tablets (iPad, Galaxy Tab, etc.) are not supported.
