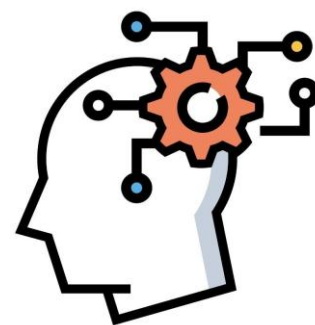
Thinking Skills for Selective (28 Sep – 2 Oct)
