> Test Sessions	On-Site ASAT: Sunday, 18 October 2026 Online Mock Tests: Access provided after the on-site ASAT
> Test Date	Students can choose either an 8:20 am or 1:30 pm start time. (Session times may vary by venue)
> Package Includes	2 Online Full-Set Mock Tests + 1 On-Site Full-Length CBT
> Test format	The test will be conducted using personal laptops (BYOD)
> Test Subjects	Reading, Writing, Mathematical reasoning & Thinking skills Tests
> Test Centre Location	Strathfield Area Rydalmere Area (Western Sydney University Parramatta South Campus) From 13 October 2026, students will receive an email containing their Test Centre Advice Letter, which will include full details of their test centre and confirmed session time.
> Registration Fee	\$110 per student (non-refundable and no credits for cancellations) Discounted \$100 applies for students enrolled in a full-term WEMT, STTC, Thinking Skills, or Writing courses (excluding holiday courses) with us in Term 1, 2 or 3 of 2026.
> Test Outcome	Parents/guardians will receive an outcome email on 1st November 2026, which will include a link to download their child's detailed test outcome reports.

COMPUTER BASED TESTS



Testing Device Minimum Requirements.

Students **must bring their own laptop (BYOD)** that meets the following requirements:

Operating system	Windows 10 or later, macOS 25 or later, or the latest Chrome OS.
Wi-Fi Connectivity	Your laptop must be capable of connecting to our local wireless network.
Battery Life	Fully charged, minimum 4 hours (no power outlets available).
Login Access	No login/security issues; child must know unlock steps.
Security Settings	Disable antivirus software, proxy configurations, and VPNs.
Antivirus	Disable any antivirus software to avoid conflicts with the ASAT platform.
Network	NO proxy or VPN settings enabled on your device.
Web Browser	Chrome is recommended. For macOS users, install the macOS version of Chrome and make sure iCloud Private Relay is disabled in System Settings app.
Device Compatibility	Tablets (iPad, Galaxy Tab, etc.) not supported.
Chromebooks	Make sure 'Guest Browsing' is enabled in Privacy & Security settings. If your Chromebook is managed by your work or school, and this option isn't available, use a Windows laptop or a MacBook instead.

Laptop Rental Option — \$50

- Laptops are available to rent at \$50 per student. Availability is very limited, and rentals will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Please indicate your rental preference during registration. Once all laptops are booked, this option will no longer be offered.
- Parents/guardians are liable for any damage caused to rental laptops.

Backup Device Policy

- If a student's BYOD laptop fails during the test, a rental laptop may be provided for a flat \$50 rental fee without parental or guardian permission.
